

Nursing Associate Apprenticeship and Nursing Apprenticeship Uniforms for External Placements

Uniforms are required particularly in external placements to help patients/service users and other staff identify learners as apprentices. In some settings learners will not be able to undertake a placement if they do not have a suitable uniform. Please find instructions below that we have been advised to share with employers within Lancashire and South Cumbria applying for a Nursing Associate Apprenticeship and/or Nursing Apprenticeship.

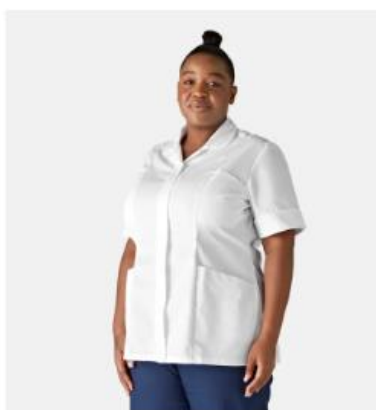
You do not need to use the supplier that is detailed within this document, this detail is just provided as an option/example to help outline the items required.

It is strongly advised your learner/s has a uniform in time for them starting the programme, to avoid any risk to accessing external placements and learners attend university days in their uniform.

The Training Hub do not finance or submit uniform requests. Uniform orders have to be completed by the employer.
