Functional Skills Apprenticeship Guidance for ICB/Providers

1. Lancashire and South Cumbria ICB and Providers

2. Guidance in Practice

16 - 18-year-old

Apprentices aged 16-18 at the start of their apprenticeship are still required to secure
up to a Level 2 Functional Skills Qualifications (FSQs) in English and maths, if they do not
already hold one.

19-year-old and over

Apprentices aged 19 and over are no longer automatically required to achieve Level 2
 FSQs in English and maths. This decision now rests with the employer rather than the
 apprentice or training provider.

If the apprentice does not hold GCSE C / 4 (or above) or Functional Skills Level 2 in English and/or maths: -

- The employer may still require FSQs for clinical safety and career progression.
 Discussion will take place with the employer, apprentice, and line manager.
- If a training provider requires English and maths (GCSE C/4 or above) or suitable
 equivalent qualification as an entry requirement onto apprenticeship, where prior
 achievement evidence cannot be produced, the completion of FSQs will be necessary.
- If English and/or maths is a regulatory requirement or is an essential component of any
 mandatory qualification and forms part of the apprenticeship gateway requirement, it
 must be completed and evidenced as part of gateway requirements unless alternative
 acceptable evidence is produced.

3. Guidance for Staff and Employers

Speak with your HR or Apprenticeship Lead or Training Provider to clarify the requirement.
