

Peripheral Venepuncture

Using Standard-ANTT in a Community Care setting



When entering the patient's home disinfect hands



Disinfect Tray as local policy - creating a General Aseptic Field



Apply Disposable **Apron**



Gather Equipment & place around tray



Disinfect Hands with alcohol hand rub or soap & water



Prepare Equipment protecting Key-Parts with nontouch technique (NTT) & Micro **Critical Aseptic Fields**



Place Drape under the patient's arm



Apply Tourniquet (use single-use disposable tourniquet) palpate vein & release tourniquet



Disinfect Hands with alcohol hand rub or soap & water



Apply Gloves (use sterile gloves if Key-Site must be touched directly)* & re-apply tourniquet



Disinfect Skin with a 2% CHG / 70% IPA using friction for 30 seconds. Allow to dry



Access Vein protecting Key-Parts & **Key-Sites** using NTT

If attempt to draw blood is unsuccessful return to step 7

If re-palpation needed, repeat step 10 or use sterile gloves*



Dispose of Sharps and equipment



Disinfect Tray according to local policy



Dispose of Gloves then apron & immediately...



Disinfect Hands with alcohol hand rub or soap & water



Dispose of Waste according to local policy



When leaving the patient's home disinfect hands
