### AIMS

Have an increased knowledge and understanding of Clinical Supervision, linking theory to practice

Differentiate between Clinical Supervision and line/performance management and between Clinical Supervision and teaching

Negotiate Clinical Supervision contracts and structure processes, accordingly, taking in to account individual learning styles

Develop reflective interpersonal and supervisory skills such as: reflective practice; giving guidance, joint problem solving, and offering feedback to enable the development of effective supervisory relationships.


